Our Lord has promised us so... Rejoice and be Glad

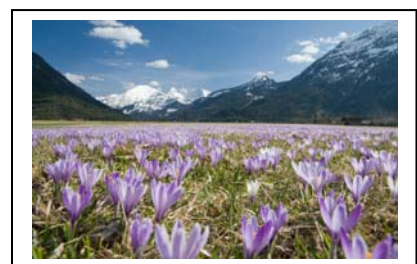
Easter Blessings ...

INSURANCE MATTERS

If you haven't visited the Knights of Columbus Web site in a while, I encourage you to do so the next time you're online. We've added many new features to www.kofc.org, but there are two that I wish to make you especially aware of.

The first is our member testimonial area, titled "Stages of Life." In this multi-media area, six "real-life" stories are told – stories of people at different stages of their lives. Chances are, one of them will sound a lot like you. These people talk about how their Knights of Columbus agent took the time to demonstrate for them the need for life insurance in their lives. 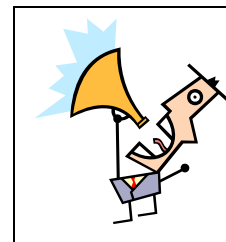

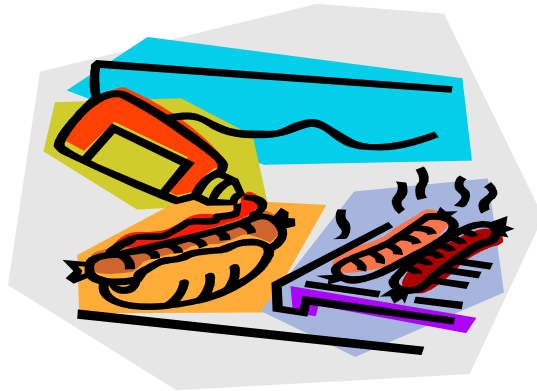
If any member has a hardship or financial needs for any reason and wishes to remain a member is advised to contact the Financial Secretary to discuss the problem in strict confidence.

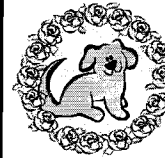

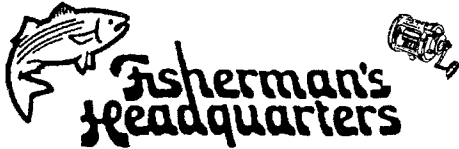
