CHAPLAINS MESSAGE

Unfortunately, at this point it is no secret that there have been tensions within our Council. We have been a very successful Council, and you have done so much good that it would be tragic to allow personalities and concerns over issues that are really minor in the big picture to derail this great legacy. In my mind, we must always remind ourselves of our basic motto: Charity, Unity and Fraternity. I cannot tell you how many times I have recalled my Third Degree and the lessons imparted that night. It was a powerful experience and impressed upon me that Charity is not a word, but a reality to be lived. There are many definitions of Charity. I would like to offer a very simple one, which is also very practical. It is acceptance of another's imperfections. When we begin to criticize others' faults, we have fallen into the trap of expecting everyone else to be perfect, while often becoming blind to our own shortcomings. It is appropriate to gently and lovingly challenge one another, but this is a far cry from speaking about or behind other people or writing them off because of mistakes or errors or faults. My advice as chaplain to restore this Council is simple: STOP! Stop the pettiness, stop the bickering. Let us return to the basics that have made the Knights a great force in the Church and have made this Council do much good – Charity, Unity and Fraternity. They are not just words. They are principles that we expect each other to live up to, but it first begins with ME.

MESSAGE FROM YOUR GRAND KNIGHT

Where do people get their ideas from? People get ideas about what is true or false from many sources, we read newspapers, books, TV, radio, internet and the spoken word. In many cases we cannot always know what is real or what is not and we accept or reject the ideas based on our religious or political beliefs, or other trusted sources. But is a trusted source always true? That source may be telling us something that sounds like a good idea or may sound truthful but how are we to know? So, do we Google some web-site to find out if it true or false or take him/her for their word? For some this is the way.

Newscasters report newsworthy stories that are informative, interesting and sometimes entertaining but at the same time the information always come from second or third hand sources. Sometimes they get the facts wrong and must correct or retract the entire story. We say OK at least they are trying to get to the truth. But do your sources do that?

In the scientific world theories are only theories and nothing is taken for fact, until it is proven through a series of tests that must prove the idea devoid of doubt. But we are not all scientists and we would not even think of doing that.

So, another question comes to mind, "*Rumors or gossip*" these are the worst of all the spoken words because they can bring out the evil in people. Rumors can destroy reputations even if it sounds harmless. Gossip most always is rooted in evil and has no basis for fact. It usually starts from someone who has an identity problem and is trying to gain our attention for social or political gain. This lends itself to lies and that is very dangerous. One example comes to mind with the 9/11 anniversary next month of how dangerous lies could be; do you remember shortly after the September 11th attack there were people making claims of injuries, or acts of heroism that were false, or people taking personal items off the fallen for profit, or cashing in on donations and misappropriating the funds. The worst was from people who were not even at ground zero making false claims for profit. Its fraud and disgusting you say? Yet there are some people who will do anything for profit or for "*15 minutes of fame*" and the spotlight. Yes, those opportunists are out there and they grab onto the coat tails of others for fame. So be cautious, you need to remain aware and use good judgment. If something sounds too good to be true, it most likely is.

Our belief in God and the written word, the book of books the Bible, has been our unchanging guiding force for centuries. Think about it, No other book can make this claim. No one to our knowledge has ever been able to disprove its writings. But there are some who doubt its words and some who pick and choose what they read or believe. 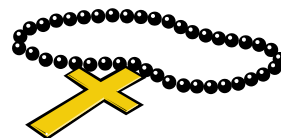
INSURANCE MATTERS

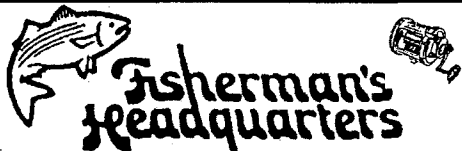

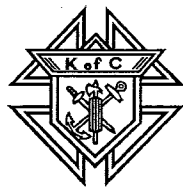

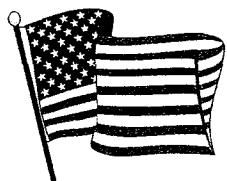
