Giving in to that doesn't help anyone, and allows others to remove the true Christmas spirit of joy and charity from our hearts. Like any good football team, we need both a good offense and defense. The game we seek to win is to help others know the peace and joy we feel in the Good News of Jesus' birth. Merry Christmas!
