Valentine's Day falls in the month of February and one of the principles of our Order is charity. I want to share this beautiful quote from St. Therese of Lisieux, the Little Flower, about love. She only lived a short life, mostly in the convent, and was sick for much of that time. In her autobiography, she said: "When I looked upon the mystical body of the Church, I recognized myself in none of the members which Saint Paul described, and what is more, I desired to distinguish myself more favorably within the whole body. Love appeared to me to be the hinge for my vocation. Indeed I knew that the Church had a body composed of various members, but in this body the necessary and more noble member was not lacking; I knew that the church had a heart and that such a heart appeared to be aflame with love. I knew that one love drove the members of the Church to action, that if this love were extinguished, the apostles would have proclaimed the Gospel no longer, the martyrs would have shed their blood no more. I saw and realized that love sets off the bounds of all vocations, that love is everything, that this same love embraces every time and every place. In one word, that love is everlasting. Then, nearly ecstatic with the supreme joy in my soul I proclaimed: O Jesus, my love, at last I have found my calling: my call is love. In the heart of the Church, my mother, I will be love, and thus I will be all things, as my desire finds its direction."

# INSURANCE MATTERS

Dear Brothers and Families,

It is with a very sad heart that I write this message. Having been a Knight for almost 47 years and the council insurance agent for the last eighteen, I have never lost so many close brothers or their spouses in such a short time. As you may be aware the past three and a half months have been a very grief stricken period for this council. It has lost 8 brothers, one spouse, and members have also lost several family members and friends.

I am also saddened because I have not been able to help all those I wanted. Many reasons come up that cause appointments to be put off, most recently the economy but also the pace of our hectic world, health issues, family activities and other responsibilities.

Those of you that personally know me personally, understand my fraternal and caring nature. It is for this reason that by way of our newsletter, I want to offer my services to all members, especially those with young families. As I have said before, because of the fraternal tax status of the Knights, if a member dies and is not an insurance member, we are not allowed to offer any of the great products that the Knights have to his widow or minor children. A member can attain "insurance status" by participating in our insurance program, purchasing long term care insurance, purchasing disability insurance or starting a retirement program with as little as \$300 (currently paying 2.75%) with no medical requirements and no need for further deposits. Please call me to discuss your specific family situation to receive the service you deserve as a Knights of Columbus member and the protection your family needs.

**Important: It's not too late. Effective 1/1/2012 for 75-80 year old members and spouses, applications now can be made for final expense whole life insurance with as little as \$10,000 of coverage. The prior cut off had been 75.**
