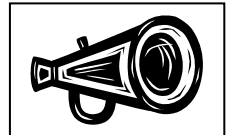

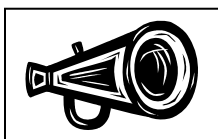


First Degree Ceremony

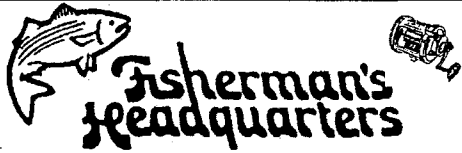

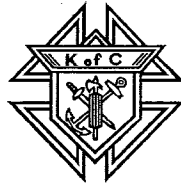

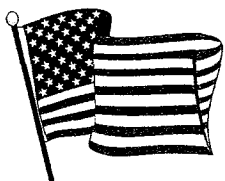
