CHAPLAINS MESSAGE

This year the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ is observed on June 14. On Holy Thursday, the Church recalls the gift of the Eucharist to us. Since that occurs during Holy Week, the sadness of the Lord's pending death adds a somber tone to what should be a joyous celebration of this wonderful sacrament. It is now observed on the Sunday after Trinity Sunday and was an outgrowth of the progressive development of worship and devotion to the Blessed Sacrament during the Middle Ages and to a revelation to St. Juliana of Liege where it was first celebrated as a local feast. In 1264, it was extended to the Universal Church. An important part of this feast is a tradition that has gradually disappeared, the Eucharistic Procession. In the spirit of restoring this most beautiful and sacred practice, St. Mary's Parish will have a process on June 14 from St. Mary of the Pines to St. Mary's, Barnegat. Given the distance and the practical challenges of walking along Route 9, we have received permission to have an automobile procession. We have limited the number of cars to 100 to make it easier for the police and to have an orderly procession. While not the same as walking by foot, we hope that this will serve as a dramatic reminder of this precious Sacrament. This feast invites us to reflect on the Eucharist as 1) The living **Memorial** of our Lord's Passion, Death, and Resurrection, which brings us its sacrificial and saving power until the end of time; 2) The great **Sacrament** by which we encounter the living risen Christ and receive strength in holiness so that all peoples may come to walk in the light of one faith, in one communion of love; 3) The sacred **Banquet** in which all are fed at God's table and grow into the holiness of the risen Christ. In this day and age when so many Catholics forget or take for granted this great gift of God, this feast is a special opportunity. As Knights, we should always be a Eucharistic people, nourished by our Lord and committed to upholding and spreading the good news of this great Sacrament!

INSURANCE MATTERS

Sometimes it is easy to overlook the simplest of things.

Take the beneficiaries on your life insurance policies. If your policy was applied for and issued several years ago, it could very well be that the beneficiary originally designated to receive the proceeds from that policy needs to be updated. If you bought the policy when you were single, for example, you may have named your parents as beneficiaries. If you have since been married, that could be updated to reflect your spouse, and even your children.

Most people list a primary beneficiary – that person is specifically designated as the first in priority to receive policy proceeds. We also encourage the naming of a contingent beneficiary – an alternate person designated to receive policy proceeds, usually in the event that the original beneficiary pre-deceases the insured.

When I call to arrange your annual “insurance check-up,” one of the matters that we can discuss is the status of your beneficiary designations. If they need updating, and they often do, I can usually complete the paperwork during the appointment.

I look forward to meeting with you to review all your life insurance policies. Please give me a call.

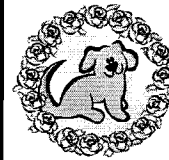

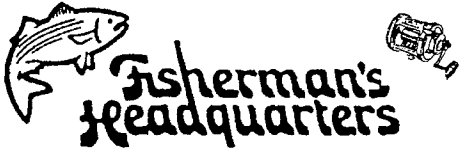

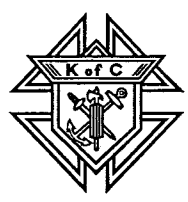
