Scott Hahn, the well-known theologian and author, has a wonderful book about Mary entitled, "Hail, Holy Queen." In another book he tells the full story of his conversion to Catholicism, but here he only mentions it briefly. In the first pages of this book he shares a story when he was fifteen. He was in school and became sick with a stomach virus. His mother was called and came into school to take him home. The relief of getting out of school quickly gave way to typical teenage horror at being seen with his mother taking him home. As he left the school, he asked his mother if she could walk ahead of him so no one would see him walking with his mom. That night, his father came to his room and reprimanded him for the way he had treated her. His father told him, "Don't ever be ashamed to be seen with your mother." As Catholics, we are not ashamed to be seen with our Mother! She is the Queen of Heaven and the mother of our Savior. Just as teenage embarrassment reveals an immaturity, we recognize that a lack of true devotion to Mary reveals an adolescent or incomplete spirituality. While there are some who have gone to the other extreme, like a child dominated by their mother, we are made better Catholics and Christians by our Blessed Mother. In the month of May, let us be grateful for Mary who helps us. We should never be ashamed to be seen with our Mother!

## INSURANCE MATTERS

The Knights of Columbus policy on replacing existing life insurance is as follows: *“The Order does not condone the practice of soliciting replacement insurance or using cash values or dividends of existing policies to finance new business. In most cases, replacement is not to the policyholder’s advantage.”*

The reasons for this are many. First, premiums usually increase on a new policy because it is issued at an older age. The older you are the more expensive life insurance is.

Many times, options available under the older policy are lost and sometimes not offered under the new policy. In addition, a new “incontestability” period begins with the new contract. The Order, for example, maintains the right to contest a claim up to two years from the issue date of the policy. A new policy brings with it a new issue date, and a new “incontestability” period.

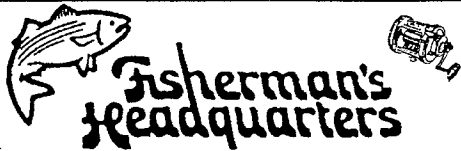

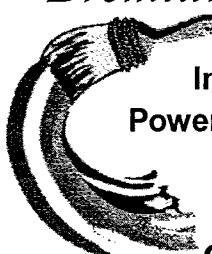
