CHAPLAINS MESSAGE

Once again, we see our beloved Church coming under attack. In this latest assault, we even see the Holy Father, himself, as the subject of the criticism. Certainly, the Church is not above reproach, and all of us are painfully aware of sinful and horrible acts and mistakes. However, what is upsetting is that we see mindless and prejudicial attacks. These criticisms are not really made to expose wrongdoing. They have as their sole purpose to destroy and tear down. Many facts are ignored and much information is overlooked. In fact, instead of seeking positive efforts to face the tragedy of abuse in all circumstances, the focus of criticism is only on the Catholic Church. Such a desire can only be considered evil. Like the demons in the Gospels who confront Jesus, they know who He is, even before the Apostles. The evil one still knows who the Lord is and tries to attack His servants. We cannot ignore real problems, but we also cannot be silent in the face of unfounded and ill-intentioned attacks. We must do so with love, accurate information, and, above all, prayer. As we approach the great feast of Pentecost, the birthday of the Church, it is a very appropriate time to renew our love of the Church and our Holy Father. We can do this by joining this special crusade of prayer to lift up our Pope Benedict. Let us surround him with a circle of protection of prayer and commitment. As Knights, you have always stood by the Church, the Pope, and its priests. For that, I thank you most sincerely. As Knights, you have always defended the same. In Rome, the Pope has the Swiss Guard to protect him from harm. May I suggest that outside of Rome he has all of you – the wonderful Knights of Columbus, defenders of the Faith! Keep up your good work. Let us pray for Pope Benedict XVI. Let us pray for the Church. Let us even pray for those who seek to destroy us – may their hearts be changed and may they, too, know the love of Jesus!

INSURANCE MATTERS

The Knights of Columbus policy on replacing existing life insurance is as follows:

“The Order does not condone the practice of soliciting replacement insurance or using cash values or dividends of existing policies to finance new business. In most cases, replacement is not to the policyholder’s advantage.”

The reasons for this are many. First, premiums usually increase on a new policy because it is issued at an older age. The older you are, the more expensive life insurance is.

Many times, options available under the older policy are lost and sometimes not offered under the new policy. In addition, a new “incontestability” period begins with the new contract. The Order, for example, maintains the right to contest a claim up to two years from the issue date of the policy. A new policy brings with it a new issue date, and a new “incontestability” period.

You purchased the life insurance you have for a reason – probably a very good reason. It is a good idea to hold onto that coverage. That doesn’t mean you have all the coverage you need or will ever need.

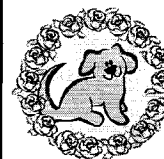

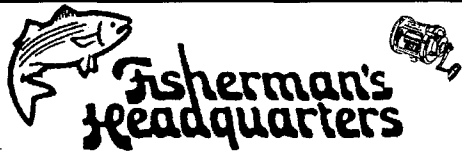

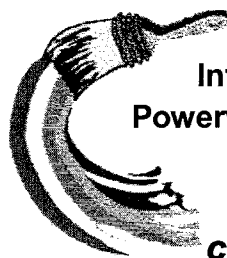
