## MESSAGE FROM YOUR GRAND KNIGHT

World War I – known at the time as “The Great War” - officially ended when the Treaty of Versailles was signed on June 28, 1919, However, fighting ceased seven months earlier when an armistice or temporary cessation of hostilities, between the Allied nations and Germany went into effect on the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month. For that reason, November 11, 1918, is generally regarded as the end of “the war to end all wars.” For many years it was celebrated as Armistice Day. Now it is known as Veterans Day. Many in my generation and those that follow know little of Word War One. But to some, that war still remains a part of family history.

On October 18th, 1918, just before the wars end, at a small farm named Talma two miles out side of Grandpre, France. Company B 312th Infantry Regiment, 78th Infantry Division, and a New Jersey Division out of Camp Dix, was assigned to over take a German machine gun nest held up in the farm house. According to a letter dating 1919, stating eyewitness accounts, a fog settled in allowing the division to secure the farm. Then the fog lifted and the Germen artillery opened up on the farmhouse. Many of our men were killed or wounded as the bombardment lasted till after nightfall preventing the evacuation of the wounded.

Joseph Lorino my wife’s Uncle was one of the wounded that Oct 18th day and he died of his wounds on Oct. 22, 1918. He now rests under a marble cross in Plot A Row 01 Grave 40 Meuse-Argonne American Cemetery, Romagne, France.

So many have sacrificed for freedom. So many take freedom for granted.

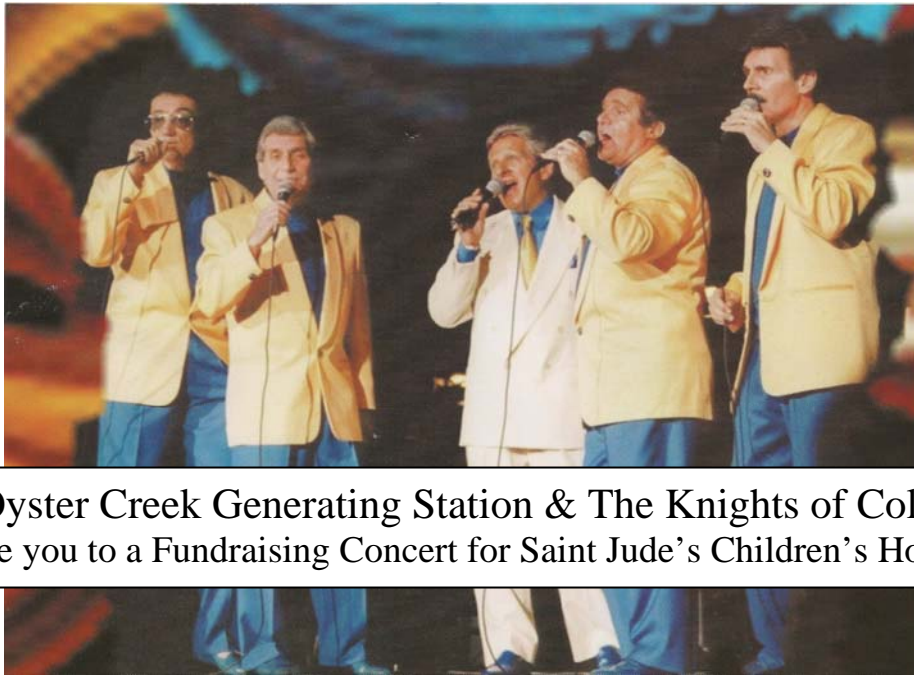

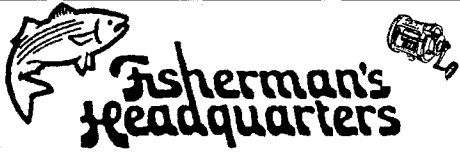
