Dear Brothers, spouses and families - I have spoken quite a bit about our great annuity plans in the past.

Since you will be reading this after October 1st, one of two things will have happened with our annuity rate.

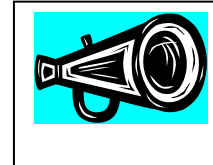

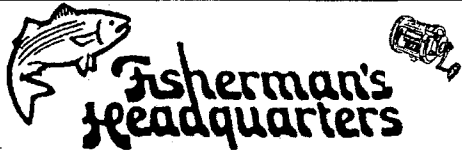

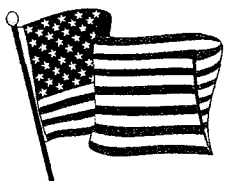
