This option is: "Go in peace, glorifying the Lord by your life." Isn't that a beautiful invitation! After all, we are called to do exactly that as Catholics. Imagine if each us actually did that – glorifying God by lives of charity, service, and love of God. Jesus taught us that when he gave us the two great commandments: love of God and love of neighbor. While this translation will not become official until the First Sunday of Advent, we can begin living it today. As Knights, indeed, let us go forth, glorifying the Lord by our lives!

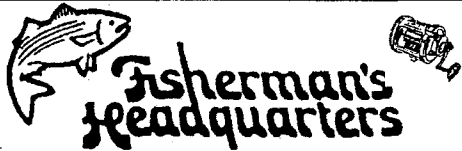
