Lent, especially for us “older” Catholics, has traditionally been a time to give up something. Many also make a commitment to attend daily Mass or Stations of the Cross. We probably don’t often give it much thought, but what we are really doing in Lent is preparing to renew our Baptismal Vows at Easter. You may remember that at each Mass on Easter, the priests asks a series of questions, to which we respond “I do.” Then, as a sign of that recommitment, we will be sprinkled with the newly blessed Easter water. As we journey through Lent, our focus should be on that moment of renewal. Here is a thought to help with that preparation. One of my favorite saints is Josephine Bakhita, who was born in the Sudan as a Muslim. Perhaps as we bless ourselves with Holy Water as we enter church, we can think of her custom. As we draw near to Easter, we can cultivate a similar appreciation for the commitment that our Baptism means and the gift of New Life that we have received.
