INSURANCE MATTERS

The Knights of Columbus policy on replacing existing life insurance is as follows:
“The Order does not condone the practice of soliciting replacement insurance or using cash values or dividends of existing policies to finance new business. In most cases, replacement is not to the policyholder’s advantage.”

The reasons for this are many. First, premiums usually increase on a new policy because it is issued at an older age. The older your are, the more expensive life insurance is.

The Order, for example, maintains the right to contest a claim up to two years from the issue date of the policy. A new policy brings with it a new issue date, and a new “incontestability” period.
